Jo Bevan works as a division 2 nurse and team leader at No Limit to Life in Sydenham. According to Jo 'No Limit to Life', "is more like a family than the usual professional carer/client relationships in workplaces".

At No Limit to Life residents live in their own units and can control what they want to do and choose when to do it. The staff make 24-hour care available if it's needed or wanted.

"I have worked in several aged care facilities before coming to No Limit to Life and the people there had no choices.

Everything was dictated to them from their breakfast time to toileting time", said Jo.

Residents can come and live at No Limit to Life villages with their partners, even if one has higher care needs than the other. People even have their pets with them and several 'No Limit to Life' residents have cats and small dogs.

"I have not seen anything else around like the care model at No Limit to Life. The high end of care includes hoists, a Division 1 nurse on site and we are able to provide palliative and respite care for people who need it", Jo said.

"You don't have to work here for long to understand why hospitals are so happy to refer people here", she said.

I love my work, said Jo, "when it was my birthday, the residents organised a cake for me and gave me presents. I was so touched by that and it confirmed my feelings that this was a very special place".
